

CVCA Bible Educator, Full-time

Summary

A CVCA Bible teacher is called to educate and cultivate servants for Christ within his or her classroom and other interactions with the CVCA student body. A Bible educator is responsible for teaching up to six sections of Bible classes, collaborating with other faculty in revising and developing the Bible curriculum at CVCA, and performing any other non-teaching duties as assigned by administration. Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy (www.cvcaroyals.org), founded in 1968, is a private, college-preparatory, non-denominational Christian Middle and High school that seeks to *educate and cultivate servants for Christ*. Students meet rigorous admissions standards both academically and spiritually. CVCA's 850 students, of whom 25% represent minority populations, come from a seven-county area. CVCA's facilities include a 145,000 square-foot building with state-of-the-art technology, 7 science labs, 2 gymnasiums, a 600-seat chapel/auditorium, and 70 acres of sports facilities, including a turf stadium and all-weather track. CVCA is fully committed to maintaining an ethnically/culturally diverse faculty and student body within a biblical community.

Position Requirements:

- Full support for CVCA's mission, vision, and core values, and unreserved agreement with CVCA's Statement of Faith
- Passion to teach Bible in a Christian school environment with the mission to educate and cultivate servants for Christ
- A clear desire and ability to teach in a student-centered learning environment
- Interest in innovatively and appropriately using technology (including Chromebooks) in the classroom to support student learning
- Strong communication skills
- Bachelor's degree in Bible, Bible education, or related field
- ACSI certification or ability to obtain ACSI certification in Bible prior to employment

Ideal Qualifications:

- Graduate degree with at least 18 hours in graduate-level Bible
- Five years' experience teaching Bible in grades 6-12 at various levels
- Demonstrated experience in innovatively and appropriately bringing Chromebooks and other technologies into the classroom to amplify and accelerate student learning
- Ability and interest in involvement in the CVCA co-curricular program (related experience preferred).
