

CVCA Middle School World Language and Culture Faculty, Part-time

Summary

A CVCA world language teacher is called to educate and cultivate servants for Christ within his or her world language classroom and other interactions with the CVCA student body. The part-time middle school world language educator is responsible for teaching four sections of language and culture classes, which include introductions to all three world languages taught at CVCA: Latin, Mandarin Chinese, and Spanish. Part-time faculty also collaborate with other teachers in revising and developing the world language curriculum at CVCA and perform any other non-teaching duties as assigned by administration. Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy (www.cvcaroyals.org), founded in 1968, is a private, college-preparatory, non-denominational Christian Middle and High school that seeks to *educate and cultivate servants for Christ*. Students meet rigorous admissions standards both academically and spiritually. CVCA's 850 students, of whom 25% represent minority populations, come from a seven-county area. CVCA's facilities include a 145,000 square-foot building with state-of-the-art technology, 7 science labs, 2 gymnasiums, a 600-seat chapel/auditorium, and 70 acres of sports facilities, including a turf stadium and all-weather track. CVCA is fully committed to maintaining an ethnically/culturally diverse faculty and student body within a biblical community.

Position Requirements:

- Full support for CVCA's mission, vision, and core values
- Passion to teach language and culture in a Christian environment with the mission to educate and cultivate servants for Christ
- A clear desire and ability to teach in a student-centered learning environment
- Interest in innovatively and appropriately using technology (including Chromebooks) in the classroom to support student learning
- Strong communication skills including full mastery of the English language
- Bachelor's degree in education or a field related to world languages or culture
- ACSI certification or ability to obtain ACSI certification prior to employment

Ideal Qualifications:

- Native speaker fluency in one or more world languages and/or extensive language immersion experience
- State of Ohio teaching certificate in a world language, Grades 6-12
- Five years' experience teaching language and culture in grades 6-12 at various levels
- Demonstrated experience in innovatively and appropriately bringing Chromebooks and other technologies into the classroom to amplify and accelerate student learning
- Ability and interest in involvement in the CVCA co-curricular program (related experience preferred).
