## **Requirements**

Position Responsibilities:

- Provides an educational program for students as defined in the student's IEP.
- Works cooperatively with regular classroom teachers, co-teaching, interpreting the abilities and disabilities of the students, assisting in classroom intervention strategies, modifying general education curricular as necessary, assisting the student with regular class assignments and in small groups.
- Communicates regularly with parents and professional staff regarding the educational, social, and personal needs of students.
- Develops and implements an IEP for each child, complementary to his/her educational strengths and needs as defined through the ETR and IEP process, and regular education curriculum
- Completes necessary reports and record keeping as required by state and local policies and procedures.
- Participates in professional growth activities through staff development, in-service, workshops, and higher education.
- Assesses students with appropriate diagnostic instruments and evaluate student's progress through the utilization of established procedures.
- Participate in IEP and ETR meetings.
- Participate in Intervention Assistance Team meetings.
- Monitor students, as assigned, in non-academic situations.
- Maintain accurate and complete student records; prepare and submit all required reports.
- Other duties assigned by administration.

- Knowledge of Ohio's Academic Content Standards

- Knowledge of IEP development
- Knowledge of current testing programs and alternate assessment
- Knowledge of behavior management techniques and effective intervention strategies
- Ability to maintain accurate student records
- Ability to evaluate student's progress through the utilization of established procedures, including alternate assessment
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Ability to maintain confidentiality while working in a home/school collaboration
